Where to recycle specific items:

Antifreeze:

Jacob's Auto Repair & Transmission, 148 Dowell Ave., Bellefontaine, 592-7233
(put in disposable container)
Mufflers Main Street, 333 South Main St., Bellefontaine, 592-5687

Appliances:

Major appliances referred to as "white goods" such as a refrigerator, freezer, washer, dryer, or hot water heater.

If you have curbside trash pick-up call your provider for a large item tag, pay the fee, and it will be picked up by the city or village trash service provider at your curb.

For "Do-It-Yourselfers" these items can be taken to:

Tuns –123 Clayton Alley Lakeview; will take any white goods, including ones with refrigerant for no charge.

Sims Brothers – Bellefontaine.

D&J Scrap Metal Yard – Bellefontaine.

Cherokee Run Landfill (See page 9 and 10 for details).

Medications:

Prescription & over the counter: Wrap each item securely and completely in duct tape, place
in a plastic bag and place in the garbage.
DO NOT FLUSH!!

Motor Oil: (Transmission fluid, brake fluid)

Do-it-yourself motor oil changers save the oil in a disposable, capped container (preferably
the original container) and recycle it. Don't pour it down a drain or sewer, or pour it on the
ground.

Oversize Items: \$25 handling fee and then weighed by the ton, \$5.00 environmental fee & 10% fuel recovery surcharge.

Mattresses: Regular & Twin - \$7.50 each piece, \$5.00 environmental fee & 10 % fuel recovery surcharge
Queen & King - \$15.00 each piece, \$5.00 environmental fee & 10% fuel recovery surcharge
